The Power2 Summit planning committee welcomes proposals from school teams, educational organizations and other stakeholders that share the impact and implications of the power of youth voice and youth-adult partnership in education. It is our goal for participants to see, hear, and feel the power of youth voice and youth-adult partnership and learn tangible tools and best practices that can be replicated in their own schools, agencies, and communities or can enhance the existing curriculum and programs.

Preference is given to presentations co-facilitated by youth and adults.

Successful proposals will address one or more of these questions:

- What does it look and sound like when young people use their voices and partner with adults as they shape their educational experience?
- What does it look and sound like when young people - in partnership with adults - speak out on issues of social justice and sustainability?
- What are our next steps to address the youth-adult relationship in our school, ensuring that power, responsibility, and joy in learning and education are shared equitably?
- What are our next steps to elevate youth voice and foster youth-adult partnership on issues of social justice and sustainability in our communities?

This is an excellent opportunity for youth and adult partnership teams to share their work, their stories, and their ideas for the future.

Teams may choose to present in a 50-minute session, or a 25-minute session if you would like to present on the same topic with another team. Please complete the following Proposal Form by March 20, 2020, and submit to Harry Frank, Program Director at UP for Learning at harry@upforlearning.org

Proposals will be reviewed by the committee in late March. You will be notified of the results in early April. Don't hesitate to contact Harry if you have any questions, changes, or concerns.
